THE PASSOVER



All of these special days of celebration are shared by Jews and Christians alike, and fall within the same calendar period.

Scripture says that on the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at dusk is the Lord's Passover. And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread unto the Lord – "seven days he shall eat unleavened bread."

The Feast of Unleavened Bread is a feast that is generally mistaken for

Passover. Passover, however, is only one 24-hour period, while the Feast of Unleavened bread lasts for seven days.

Historically, the festival called "Easter" was a pre-Christian pagan holiday. It was the festival of "Ishtar" – which is pronounced "Easter" and was a day that commemorated the resurrection of one of their gods that they called "Tammuz". We find Easter in the Bible in Acts 12.4 because evil King Herod was planning to celebrate the holiday – not the Christians. Most of
