WARREN ANDERSON has led a very fascinating life. He was born and raised in Northern Minnesota. At 14, he worked on the railroad pounding spikes, worked in iron mines, and was the youngest person to fly an airplane. He obtained a seaplane license at 16 years old.

After graduating from the University of Colorado, he embarked on an illustrious career as an Electronic State of the Art Designer. He and his team developed Loran-C, a hyperbolic military tracking system used worldwide that located atomic bombs in the Pacific. It was the forerunner to the commercial tracking system we use today called GPS.

Warren designed missile hardware for the Titan II and Titan III intercontinental ballistic missiles. He was the designer of a satellite command and monitoring system and a redundant computer.


As lead engineer, he designed hardware for the Apollo 11

spacecraft that landed on the moon and received the coveted award, a statue of an astronaut.

Warren has traveled the world visiting 28 countries (some three times) including China and Russia and has been to 49 states. His favorite destination is Italy.

Married twice, he is dad to four sons and says his second wife was lovely inside and out.
